1. Logistics and storehouse development

Investments realized in the Central Hungarian Region (Budapest and Pest county) cannot be subsidized.

- ▼ SME-s and large companies
- ▼ Grant intensity:
 - 50%- in case of intermodal logistic centers,
 - 40%- in case of regional logistic centers,
 - 30%- in case of service development in the field of logistics.
- ▼ Grant amount:
 - regional: HUF 25 – 250 M
 - intermodal: HUF 25 – 750 M
- ▼ Submission: March 1 – December 31 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities:
 - Infrastructural and property investment
 - Purchase of new machines and appliances
 - Costs of project planning and preparation
 - IT development (software and hardware purchase)
 - Costs of entering new markets
 - HR development, training
 - Consultancy costs
 - Costs of introducing environment-, quality- and other management systems (applicant may require advanced payment in up to 25%)

2. Technology and Infrastructural development

Technology development I.

Projects realized in Hungary

- ▼ Only micro-enterprises may apply
- ▼ Amount of non-refundable subsidy: HUF 1-4 M
- ▼ Intensity of non-refundable subsidy: up to 45%
- ▼ Amount of refundable subsidy HUF 1-8 M
- ▼ Intensity of refundable subsidy: 60%
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities
 - Purchase of new machines and appliances
 - Infrastructural and property development
 - Costs of real-estate construction, expansion, development or refurbishing
 - Real-estate purchase
 - IT development (software and hardware)
- ▼ Advanced payment is not available

Technology development II.

Projects realized in Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Large enterprises may not apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 20%-35%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy HUF 5-25 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities:
 - Purchase of new machines or appliances
 - IT development (software and Hardware)
- ▼ Advanced payment is not available

Projects realized outside Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Major enterprises may not apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 30%-40%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy HUF 5-25 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities
 - Purchase of new machines and appliances
 - IT development (software and hardware)
- ▼ Advanced payment is not available

Technology development III.

Projects realized in Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Micro-and small enterprises, in Pest County medium enterprises as well
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy up to 20%-35 %
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 15-100 M
- ▼ Submission deadline : March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities:
 - Purchase of new machines and appliances
 - Infrastructure and real-estate investment
 - Production license, know-how
 - IT development (software and hardware)
 - Costs of market penetration
 - HR development, training
 - Consultancy costs
 - Costs of introducing environment-, quality- and other management systems
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25%

Projects realized outside Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Major enterprises may not apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: up to 25%-35%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 15-100 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities:
 - Purchase of new machines and appliances
 - Infrastructural and real-estate investment
 - Production license, know-how
 - IT development (software and hardware)
 - Costs of entering new markets
 - HR development, training
 - Consultancy costs
 - Costs of introducing environment-, quality- and other management systems
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25%

Technology and Employment

Projects realized outside Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Small-, medium- and large enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: up to 35% (depending on the size of the project and the number of new workplaces created)
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 100-1.000 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities:
 - Wage subsidy for up to 18 months
 - Purchase of new machines and appliances
 - Infrastructural and real-estate investment (up to 30%)

- Production license, know-how (up to 10%)
 - IT development : hardware purchase
 - IT development: software purchase (up to 5 % and HUF 50 M)
 - Costs of new market penetration (up to 5% and HUF 50 M)
 - HR development (up to 5% and HUF 50 M)
 - Consultancy costs (up to 5% and HUF 50 M)
 - Costs of introducing environment-,quality- and other management systems (up to 5% and HUF 50 M)
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 10%

3. Training Subsidy

Training subsidy for micro- and small enterprises

only for projects realized outside Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Micro- and small enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: up to 80%
 - For general education: 60%;
 - For vocational training: 25%
which may be increased by:
 - 10% in case of employees living with disabilities or underprivileged employees
 - 20% in case while the subsidy is given to SME
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 5 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: continuous submission starting on March 1st, 2011
- ▼ Only within the frames of projects winning one of the New Széchenyi Plan's economy development calls for application may apply for the following:
 - vocational training
 - foreign language training
 - training in connection with company management (finance, accounting, taxing, etc.)
 - IT and computer skills training
 - labor-and health safety
- ▼ Within the frames of this grant only trainings offered by FAT accredited institutes maybe requisitioned.
- ▼ The requisitioned training must be accredited or contained in the National Qualifications Register (OKJ), and only trainings that end with examinations are accepted.
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: HUF 1 M

Workplace training for medium enterprises

only for projects realized outside Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Medium enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 100%
 - In case of "de minimis" subsidy: 100%
 - In case of training subsidy: 80%
 - In case of general education: 60%
 - In case of vocational training: 25%
which maybe increased by
 - 10% in case of employees living with disabilities or underprivileged employees
 - 10% in case the subsidy is given to an SME

- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 1 - 50 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: continuous submission starting on March 1st, 2011
- ▼ Only within the frames of projects winning one of the New Széchenyi Plan's economy development calls for application may apply for the following:
 - vocational training
 - foreign language training
 - training in connection with company management (finance, accounting, taxing, etc.)
 - IT and computer skills training
 - labor-and health safety
- ▼ Within the frames of this grant only trainings offered by FAT accredited institutes maybe requisitioned.
- ▼ The requisitioned training must be accredited or contained in the National Qualifications Register (OKJ), and only trainings that end with examinations are accepted.
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25%

4. Corporate cooperation and Clusters

Projects realized in Hungary

- ▼ Small-medium- and large enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 10-80%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 10-150 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – April 29th, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities:
 - Costs related to cluster management
 - Joint investment of corporations and developing clusters
 - Purchase of used or new machines and appliances
 - Infrastructural and real-estate investment
 - Production license, know-how
 - IT development (software and hardware)
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25%

Corporate innovation subsidy available for clusters outside Budapest and Pest County (experimental development, market penetration)

- ▼ Micro, small end medium enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 25 – 55%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 15 – 500 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized activities related to development leading age, highly innovative prototypes:
 - Wage cost
 - R+D services from third party
 - R+D expenditures
 - Purchase of appliances related to R+D
 - IT development (software and hardware) related to R+D
 - Infrastructural and real-estate development related to R+D

- Production licenses and know-how related to the purchase of appliances
- Market penetration (services, material costs, wage costs)
- Industrial property protection
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25%

5. Research and development, innovation

Corporate innovation subsidy in Budapest and Pest County (experimental development, market penetration)

- ▼ Micro, small-,medium and large enterprises may enter
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 10 – 45%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 15 – 500 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized activities related to development of highly innovative material:
 - Wage cost
 - R+D services
 - R+D expenditures
 - Purchase of appliances related to R+D
 - IT development (software and hardware) related to R+D
 - Infrastructural and real-estate development related to R+D
 - Production licenses and know-how related to the purchase of appliances
 - Market penetration (services, material costs, wage costs)
 - Industrial property protection
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25 %

Corporate Innovation subsidy outside Budapest and Pest County (experimental development, market penetration)

- ▼ Micro, small, medium and large enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 25 – 45%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF15 – 500 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized activities related to development of leading age, highly innovative prototypes:
 - Wage cost
 - R+D services
 - R+D expenditures
 - Purchase of appliances related to R+D
 - IT development (software and hardware) related to R+D
 - Infrastructural and real-estate development related to R+D
 - Production licenses and know-how related to the purchase of appliances
 - Market penetration (services, material costs, wage costs)
 - Industrial property protection
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25 %

Utilization of SME's innovation results for projects realized in Hungary

- ▼ Micro, small and medium enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 65%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 5 – 25 M

- ▼ Submission deadline: March 1st – December 31st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized activities related to
 - adapting or developing already existing, marketable products and services, or
 - expansion of related production or services and
 - industrial property protection:
 - Wage costs
 - Purchase of used or new appliances related to R+D
 - Costs related to protection of industrial property, costs of industrial property protection
- ▼ Advanced payment is not available

6. Energetic development

Supply of local heating and cooling needs with renewable energy /A/ for projects realized outside Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Micro, small and medium enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 30% – 60%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 1 – 50 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: continuous submission starting on March 1st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities:
 - Supply of heating needs partly or fully on the basis of renewable energy
 - Supply of hot water for domestic use partly or fully on the basis of renewable energy
 - Supply of hot water for industrial use partly or fully on the basis of renewable energy
 - Electricity production utilizing solar panels
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25 %

Supply of local heating and cooling needs based on renewable energy sources /B/ for projects realized outside of Budapest and Pest County

- ▼ Micro, small and medium enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 30% – 60%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 1 – 1.000 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: continuous submission starting on March 1st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities:
 - Utilizing solar energy
 - Use of biomass
 - Development of improvement of local heat supply systems and production of biogas and deponia gas out of solid or liquid raw material
 - Use of geothermal energy
 - Installation of heat pump systems
 - Supply of cooling needs utilizing renewable energy

- Utilization of wind power
- Combining renewable resources
- Installation of district-heating systems using renewable resources, switching partly or fully to renewable resources
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25 %

Production of renewable resource-based electric power, combined heat and electric power and bio-methane

For projects realized outside of Budapest and Pest County:

- ▼ Micro, small and medium enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of subsidy: 30% - 60%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 1 – 1.000 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: continuous submission starting with March 1st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities: (heating-cooling, electric power generation)
 - Solar energy based electric power generation
 - Utilization of biomass in electric power or combined heat and electric power generation
 - Utilization of water resources: construction or development of water plants below 5 MW, as well as of their network connection
 - Biogas production and utilization
 - Utilization of geothermic energy
 - Utilization of wind energy
 - Combining renewable resources
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25 %

Building-energetic development combined with renewable resource utilization in case of projects realized in Hungary:

- ▼ Micro, small and medium enterprises may apply
- ▼ Intensity of Subsidy: 30% - 70%
- ▼ Amount of subsidy: HUF 1 – 500 M
- ▼ Submission deadline: continuous submission starting on March 1st, 2011
- ▼ Subsidized costs and activities
 - Improvement of energy efficiency with utilizing renewable resources e.g.:
 - Posterior exterior sealant
 - Change of doors and windows
 - Creating heat recovering airing systems
 - Modernization of non-production purpose heating-cooling and domestic water systems
 - Modernization of lighting systems
- ▼ Possible advanced payment: up to 25 %
